Kraków Airport Balice

In Kraków **can be found** the following:

- the seat of the Polish Academy of Arts and Sciences
- a branch of the **Polish Academy of Sciences** with 21 units
- the headquarters of the National Science Centre
- SOLARIS National Synchrotron Radiation Centre

The SOLARIS Synchrotron (electron accelerator) is used by scientists from Poland and abroad to conduct complex experiments in the fields of physics, chemistry, medicine, pharmacology, geology and material engineering. **Prometheus** – the most powerful supercomputer in the history of Poland was constructed and launched in the AGH University of Science and Technology in Kraków (AGH) and ranks at 131st place in the TOP 500 fastest computers in the world.

The **LifeScience** Cluster – 75 members: companies, higher education institutions, business environment institutions, scientific and research entities, administration.



KRAKsat 2019 – research satellite sent into space by students of AGH and UJ. KRAKsat is one of the first Cubesat type satellites in Poland and the world's first satellite that uses ferrofluid, a magnetic fluid, to control orientation.

Thanks to the activities of venture capital funds, business cooperation, universities and incubators of innovation, Kraków is one of the largest start-up centres in Poland.

It is easy to find the following startups in Kraków: IoT, AI, VR, Blockchain, Industry 4.0, EduTech, MedTech and even Cybersecurity.

The top 8 Kraków start-ups raised the total capital of **over PLN 500 mln.**

The top 8 Kraków start-ups employ **approx. 800 people.** Mainly highly qualified specialists.

All of the TOP companies sell their products on the international market.

Kraków ranked at 3th place in the CBRE ranking **"EMEA Tech Cities" in the "Growth Clusters"** category among cities with the largest growth potential in the technology sector in Europe.

Employment in the hi-tech sector in Kraków has increased by 66 % in last 10 years.







In the **Top 10 Polish Cities of the Future** ranking fDi 2019/2020 Kraków turned out to be **the best location** among regional cities.

In three categories: economic potential, human capital and lifestyle, as well as business friendliness, Kraków was ranked high on **the 2nd place**





In the **Top 5 Large Polish Cities of the Future ranking fDi 2019/2020** Kraków took **2nd place** in four categories, and 5th place in the cost effectiveness category. It means that the capital of Małopolska offering the high standard of living and urban infrastructure, competes with quality rather than low price, being at the same time the most advantageous location in Europe for the shared services sector.

Kraków was recognized for its comprehensive low emission reduction and air quality improvement program, as well as the implementation of low emission public transport – **the National Ecological Council granted the city the title of laureate of the National Ecological Award "Ekojanosik – Zielona Wstęga Polski"**.

Kraków in the Forbes 2019 ranking received 2nd place in the category **"The most** ecological city in Poland".

- Lamusownia a modern collection point of recyclable materials
- the Waste Incineration Plant a modern place which makes energy from waste
- Kraków and Małopolska region first in Poland to enact Anti-smog Resolution

The first bus line in Poland operated exclusively by **electric vehicles** was opened in Kraków.

It is currently:

- 26 electric buses
- 34 hybrid buses.

In plans to purchase up to 161 electric buses.

Kraków is the first city in Poland to introduce bus lanes to the road traffic.

Kraków is the European Capital of Gastronomic Culture 2019.

The title was awarded for the first time by the European Academy of Gastronomy.

- Kraków has its own culinary guide "Kraków on the fork".

Kraków has a modern congress and entertainment infrastructure, including:

The Tauron Arena Kraków – multifunctional venue with 2 performance and sports halls: 15.000 seats and 9.000 standing places on the playing area.

The ICE Kraków Congress Centre -

37 thousand seats, including the auditorium hall – 2.000 seats, 500 m² of meeting and conference rooms.

Kraków is the host city of the **15th World Congress of the OWHC.** The Organization of World Heritage Cities (OWHC) is composed of more than 300 cities in which are located sites included on the UNESCO World Heritage List.

Kraków the World City of Festivals and Cultural Events 2016. Every year in Kraków takes place nearly **100 festivals**, the biggest events include: Misteria Paschalia Festival, Sacrum Profanum Festival, Opera Rara, Unsound Festival, Jewish Culture Festival, Street Theater Festival, Divine Comedy International Theater Festival, Film Music Festival, Krakow Film Festival, Off Camera and literary: Miłosz Festival and Conrad Festival.
